Please note: for a Troop or Crew to be able to submit an adult for consideration, the unit must have a successful election resulting in the election of at least one youth member.

Page three of this citation must be complete, including the Date of Birth.

Page four of this citation must include details and dates of each event.

### dult Membership Qualifications

All members of, or candidates for membership in, the Order of the Arrow who are 21 years of age or older and are registered members of the Boy Scouts of America, shall be considered adult members or candidates for adult membership. Induction of adult members shall be at the discretion of the Lodge Adult Citation Review Committee. Individuals shall be selected as candidates based upon the following requirements:

#### Adult Leaders in Units

Adult leaders in units: Each year, upon holding a Troop, Crew or Ship election for youth candidates that results in at least one youth candidate being elected, the Unit Committee may nominate adults to the Lodge Adult Citation Review Committee. The number of adults nominated can be no more than one-third of the number of youth candidates elected, rounded up where the number of youth candidates is not a multiple of three. In addition to the one-third limit, the Unit Committee may nominate the currently serving Unit Leader (but not Assistant Leaders), as long as he or she has served as Unit Leader for at least the previous 12 months.

Recommendations of the Lodge Adult Citation Review Committee, with the approval of the Scout Executive, serving as Supreme Chief of the Fire, will be candidates for induction, provided the following conditions are fulfilled:

- Selection of an adult is based upon ability to perform the necessary functions to help the Order of the Arrow fulfill its purpose, and not for recognition of service, including current or prior achievement and position.
- The individual will be an asset to the Order of the Arrow because of demonstrated abilities that fulfill the purpose of the Order of the Arrow.
- The camping requirements set forth for youth members are fulfilled.
- The adult leader's membership will provide a positive example for the growth and development of the youth members of the lodge.

#### **Adult Leaders in Council and District Positions**

The Lodge Adviser, District Chairs, Council President, or members of the Professional Staff may nominate adults to the Lodge Adult Citation Review Committee. All requirements set forth for adult leaders in Units must be fulfilled, with the exception of the camping requirements, which may be waived at the discretion of the Lodge Adviser and Scout Executive. Recommendations of the Lodge Adult Citation Review Committee, with the approval of the Scout Executive, serving as Supreme Chief of the Fire, will become candidates for induction.

Adults may be nominated for membership only one time per year as either Unit Scouters or District/Council Scouters, but not both. How they are nominated depends on where they maintain their primary registration.

Because the Order of the Arrow is principally a youth organization, Unit, District, and Council Scouters are not selected for membership as a recognition. Selection should take place only when the adult's position in Scouts BSA or Venturing will make Order of the Arrow membership more meaningful in the lives of the youth membership.

The deadline for all adult selections is May 31st.

This citation must be received by the Council Service Center by May 31<sup>st</sup> or it will not be processed. Any selection held at a later time will not be accepted and there will be no selections made at camp.

Units with extenuating circumstances should contact the Cho-Gun-Mun-A-Nock Lodge's Unit Elections Adviser no later than April 30<sup>th</sup>. The Unit Elections Adviser contact info can be found on the Lodge website.

All selected candidates must be called out and complete the Ordeal experience and participate in the induction ceremony at Fall Conclaves, the April Ordeal Opportunity, or Spring Conclave following callout, to become members of the Order of the Arrow.
