



Job Description: Eagle Quest Instructor

Essential Functions: The Eagle Quest Instructor is responsible in assisting with the first-year camper program and reports to Eagle Quest Director. Eagle Quest Instructor must possess the ability to work with Scouts and adult leaders. The Eagle Quest Instructors must be cheerful, sincere, tactful, creative, and above all strongly motivated by the Scouting program.

Principle Responsibilities:

- Managing a quality daily campcraft program including merit badge instruction as assigned, special demonstrations, and advancement opportunities for those Scouts working on the rank of Scout through First-Class.
- Teaching of Merit Badges as assigned in the lesson plans.
- Participating actively in overnight campouts. (as assigned)
- Providing a positive learning experience to Scouts in the Eagle Quest program.
- Completing and submitting all advancement forms, merit badge cards, and other paperwork pertaining to the area.
- Keep a current inventory of equipment to ensure it's in good repair.
- During the end of the summer camping season, complete a written close-out report of the Eagle Quest program and will be submitted to the Eagle Quest Director before leaving the camp property.
- Working with the Eagle Quest Director, develop daily lesson plans for the Eagle Quest program.
- Participate in camp wide activities, as needed.
- Assist in the set-up and takedown of all aquatic and campsite facilities.
- All other duties assigned.

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
