



Job Description: Ecology Instructor

Essential Functions: The Ecology Instructor reports to the Ecology Director. The Ecology Instructor is responsible for teaching campers about the natural environment. The Ecology Instructor should possess a strong background in natural history, ecology, or other related fields. They must enjoy working with youth to be creative and enthusiastic of nature and conservation.

Principle Responsibilities:

- Assist in keeping the Ecology/Conservation Area clean and neat with related displays.
- Assist in the supervision of demonstrations or activities related to nature.
- Reviewing and becoming familiar with the natural history and conservation aspects of the Camp and surrounding areas.
- Assist youth and leaders in planning, coordinating, and conducting nature activities.
- Assist in collecting/preparing Advancement Report Cards, MB Cards and other paperwork as needed.
- Participate in all camp wide activities.
- Assist in integrating sound ecological practices and thought into all aspects of the Camp program.
- Assist youth and leaders in recognizing the nature program opportunities available to them both in and out of Camp.
- Assist in the set-up and takedown of all campsite facilities.
- All other duties as assigned.
