NOTES:

- 1. Table 3-1 and this table together make up the duty responsibilities for adults.
- 2. The color of an adult's callout bead is white if the Ordeal was taken as a youth and black if taken as an adult.
- 3. The basic Indian style OA Regalia is defined in section 5.2.5 of the Lodge Membership Guide.
- 4. The sash will be either a Brotherhood or Vigil sash depending on membership level.
- 5. Counseling Brotherhood candidates consists of helping candidates with their Brotherhood requirements at Chapter Meetings and at least one Conclave or Fellowship.
- 6. Counseling Ordeal candidates consists of leading an Ordeal counseling session at a Conclave using the guidelines provided. This includes explaining the Ordeal up to the time of the Counseling session.
- 7. All requirements for any given Duty, except this one, must be completed within the twelve months prior to applying for that Duty Promotion.
- 8. If there is a strong conflict, contact, in order, the Lodge Adviser, the Lodge Chief, or the Lodge Professional Adviser for a substitute responsibility.
- 9. Requirement 13 for the Red Duty is waived for those members who achieve Red Duty outside the Indian Lore path.
