## **NOTES:**

- 1. Table 3-1 and this table together make up the Duty responsibilities for youth.
- 2. The basic Indian style OA Regalia is defined in section 5.2.5 of this Lodge Membership Guide.
- 3. The sash will be either a Brotherhood or Vigil sash depending on membership level.
- 4. Counseling Brotherhood candidates consists of helping candidates with their Brotherhood requirements at Chapter Meetings and at least one Conclave or Fellowship.
- 5. All requirements for any given Duty, except this one, must be completed within the twelve months prior to applying for that Duty Promotion.
- 6. If there is a strong conflict, contact, in order, the Lodge Adviser, the Lodge Chief, or the Lodge Staff Adviser for a substitute responsibility.
- 7. Requirement 14 for the Red Duty is waived for those members who achieve Red Duty outside the Indian lore path.
