## **Lodge Officer Candidacy Guidelines & Procedures**

Per the Constitution and By-laws of the Cho-Gun-Mun-A-Nock Lodge (Article II, Section G), an Arrowman must satisfactorily meet the following guidelines for the nomination to be officially recognized by the Lodge:

1. A commitment to attend all major Lodge events during the year.  
(Winter Banquet, Spring Fellowship, Spring Conclave, Fall Conclave)
2. Candidate must not turn 21 during the term for which you are seeking election.
3. A **TYPED** letter of intent, including what office you are seeking.
4. A letter of recommendation from either an adult Adviser or a youth leader of the Lodge (preferably typed) that can relate to your ability to perform successfully in the office in which you are seeking.
5. A petition signed by no less than 10 active youth Arrowman.
  - a. No more than five can be from the candidate's home Chapter.
  - b. Candidates must use the petition form supplied by the Lodge to ensure uniformity and accuracy.
6. All documentation must be entirely complete for the nomination to be added to the Lodge Officer election ballot.
7. All nomination documentation must be submitted to the Lodge Adviser no later than 11:00pm Friday night of Fall Conclave.
  - a. Not meeting this deadline will jeopardize your nomination.
