Lodge Officer Candidacy Guidelines & Procedures

Per the Constitution and By-laws of the Cho-Gun-Mun-A-Nock Lodge (Article II, Section G), an Arrowman must satisfactorily meet the following guidelines for the nomination to be officially recognized by the Lodge:

- 1. A commitment to attend all major Lodge events during the year. (Winter Banquet, Spring Fellowship, Spring Conclave, Fall Conclave)
- 2. Candidate must not turn 21 during the term for which you are seeking election.
- 3. A **TYPED** letter of intent, including what office you are seeking.
- 4. A letter of recommendation from either an adult Adviser or a youth leader of the Lodge (preferably typed) that can relate to your ability to perform successfully in the office in which you are seeking.
- 5. A petition signed by no less than 10 active youth Arrowman.
 - a. No more than five can be from the candidate's home Chapter.
 - b. Candidates must use the petition form supplied by the Lodge to ensure uniformity and accuracy.
- 6. All documentation must be entirely complete for the nomination to be added to the Lodge Officer election ballot.
- 7. All nomination documentation must be submitted to the Lodge Adviser no later than 11:00pm Friday night of Fall Conclave.
 - a. Not meeting this deadline will jeopardize your nomination.

All questions should be directed to the Lodge Chief, Lodge Adviser or Lodge Staff Adviser.
